ENCLOSURE B – Revision to 2015-16 Parent/Student Handbook

ACT has yet to post scores for our junior class. In the event that scores are not available by Thursday morning (May 19, 2016), the Board approved using Performance Series growth results to determine exemptions for grade 11 for Benchmark testing in place of ACT test scores. The revision to the 2015-16 Parent/Student Handbook will read as follows (page 61):

6. Students in grade 11 who benchmark on all subtests of the ACT will be exempt from all 4th nine-weeks final FCS benchmark tests. In the event that Spring ACT score reports are not available in time to determine exemptions, Performance Series growth results will be used to make the determination.

ENCLOSURE C – Declaration of Surplus Property

The Board approved declaring excess iPads that are not needed by our district as surplus property. The surplus property (iPads) declared will be sold to other school districts in the State of Alabama at a negotiated price based on fair market value of the devices. The Boards of Education who are purchasing the devices will be responsible for transporting the iPads to their district.

The Board approved declaring excess tables, chairs, desks, Child Nutrition equipment, and other items found not usable by Florence City Schools as surplus property which will be sold at a public auction or sold for scrap (whichever benefits the district more) during the summer of 2016. Most of the unused items will be from the downsizing of Florence Middle School as they move to the temporary modular campus.
