**ENCLOSURE B – Resolution for Partnership Between  
Florence City Schools  
and New York Institute of Technology**

**RESOLUTION**

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Florence City Board of Education and the Florence City Schools Superintendent, in conjunction with the New York Institute of Technology and four other national project sites, establish a three-year partnership entitled Technology-Empowered Teacher Center project (TETC); and

**WHEREAS**, the TETC project focuses on the implementation of effective, innovative and focused professional learning experiences for teachers through the utilization of technology tools and resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the TETC project establishes a collaborative decision-making model enabling a broad base of stakeholders to participate in curriculum and professional learning decisions; and

**WHEREAS**, Florence City Schools will receive an anticipated budget of \$85,000 per year to support personnel specifically focused on the work of the TETC project; and

**WHEREAS**, Florence City Schools will have access to additional funding resources in such categories as consultants, teacher stipends, equipment and travel; and

**WHEREAS**, Florence City Schools will work with staff from the New York Institute of Technology and four other national sites to: (1) establish a TETC Advisory Committee and collaborative decision-making model, (2) identify and prioritize professional learning experiences for teachers that support the goals of the district and the substance of the digital initiative, (3) identify resources to support on-going professional learning for teachers necessary to deliver information via technology interfaces, (4) share resources, best practices and professional learning models with other national sites, and (5) participate in a comprehensive evaluation of the success of the model and its potential for the future.
