Issuance of Board's \$35,685,000 Tax Anticipation School Warrants, Series 2017

The Board approved a resolution for the issuance of the Board's \$35,685,000 principal amount of Tax Anticipation School Warrants, Series 2017, to be dated June 1, 2017 and issued on June 6, 2017, the proceeds of which will be issued to (1) advance refunding and redeem as \$8,510,000 principal portion of the Board's outstanding Tax Anticipation School Warrants, Series 2012, dated March 1, 2012, and previously issued on March 14, 2012; (2) construct certain capital improvements to the Board's educational facilities in the approximate amount of \$26,000,000, to consist of a new middle school, and (3) pay issuance expenses.
