1. The Board approved the bid for copier paper submitted by Paper and Chemical in the amount of \$26.50 per case.

2. The Board approved the bid for software submitted by CISCO Prime Wireless in the amount of \$17,210.38. The software will be used for all sites in the district.
3. The Board approved a 3-year proposal submitted by Discovery Education to provide unlimited streaming of educational resources, including lesson plans, interactive digital content, video clips, etc., all of which will work in conjunction with our 1:1 iPad Initiative and will support Standards-based instruction. In addition, Discovery Education will provide online "Techbooks" for Science in Grades 7-12 and Social Studies in Grades 6-8. Professional Development is included to ensure that teachers have the necessary training to implement Discovery Education effectively into daily instruction. The cost of the 3-year investment is \$92,574.00 and is being funded by textbook monies.
4. The Board approved the Florence Band Boosters request to purchase and finance band equipment in the amount of \$27,459 from Gadsden Music Company. The purchase does not have to follow the bid law of any item over \$15,000 due to the fact that the purchase will be paid from only Band Booster funds (non-public revenue).

ENCLOSURE E – Policy Revision

The Board approved a revision to the Florence City Schools Policy manual, Section VI., Students, 6.16 Corporal Punishment as presented for first reading at the March 11, 2014, Board meeting. The only revision to the policy is to change the allowable grades for corporal punishment from grades K-6 to K-4.
