CHORUS I (Formerly CONCERT CHOIR I) (Grades 9-12)

FEE: \$10.00

The student must perform an individual audition for admission into this course. In this first year, the student learns the basics of choral music and of participation in a choral group. It lays the foundation for student *Courses listed below may be taken to satisfy Arts or Elective credit on an individual basis.*

For students wishing to pursue the Fine Arts Distinction, if chorus is the declared study, there are multiple pathways which include success in the vocal music world.

CHORUS II (Formerly CONCERT CHOIR II) (Grades 10-12)

FEE: \$10.00

Prerequisites: Chorus I

Moving into the second year of vocal music instruction, the student masters more challenging vocal scores and performs at school and community events, as well as in regional and state competitions.

CHORUS III (Formerly CONCERT CHOIR III) (Grades 11-12)

FEE: \$10.00

Prerequisites: Chorus II

Through direct instruction and practice, the student in this course accepts the challenge of learning advanced musical compositions. To gain self-confidence and to showcase the skills attained, he/she performs and competes in a wide variety of venues.

CHORUS IV (Formerly CONCERT CHOIR IV) (Grade 12)

FEE: \$10.00

Prerequisites: Chorus III

Under the skilled tutelage of the vocal music instructor, the student in this course confidently approaches more advanced choral music and the scheduled competitions at the regional and state levels. Performances of all types and in a range of settings take place throughout the school year.

INTRO TO SHOW CHOIR I (Grades 9-12)

FEE: \$10.00

Prerequisites: Audition only

Beginning-levels in both choreography and vocals characterize this course. The student learns stage presence and has many opportunities to practice and perform with Florence High School's award-winning Show Choir. *NOTE: Participation in Show Choir meets the requirement for the one unit of credit in Physical Education.*

COMPETITION SHOW CHOIR II (Grades 10-12)

FEE: \$10.00

Prerequisites: Audition only and must have participated in Show Choir I

Building on the skills acquired in Show Choir I, both choreographic and vocal, the student receives direct instruction and participates in numerous practice sessions to advance his/her skills. There are performances scheduled throughout the school year, all leading toward the major production at year's end. *NOTE: Participation in Show Choir meets the requirement for the one unit of credit in Physical Education.*

COMPETITION SHOW CHOIR III (Grades 11-12)

FEE: \$10.00

Prerequisites: Audition only and must have participated in Show Choir II

Advanced levels of both choreography and vocals are the focus of this course. Through this third-year course, the student assumes leadership roles as he/she gains the self-confidence that public performances bring about. Participation in regional and state competitions is required. *NOTE: Participation in Show Choir meets the requirement for the one unit of credit in Physical Education.*

COMPETITION SHOW CHOIR IV (Grade 12)

FEE: \$10.00

Prerequisites: Audition only and must have participated in Show Choir III

The student in Show Choir IV is a seasoned veteran on the stage. He/she accepts the challenges posed by advanced vocals and advanced choreography, helping the Show Choir to live up to its statewide recognition as an award-winning group. Performances and competitions continue as an integral part of the course. *NOTE: Participation in Show Choir meets the requirement for the one unit of credit in Physical Education.*
